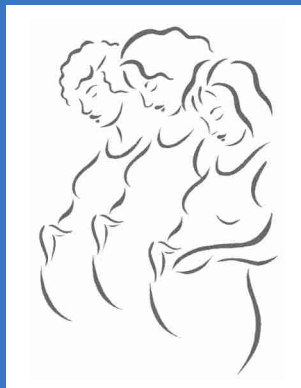

About Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders

FASD describes the full range of alcohol-related disabilities caused by prenatal exposure to alcohol, including Fetal Alcohol Syndrome (FAS).

Individuals with FASD face lifelong physical, cognitive, and behavioral challenges that interfere with relationships, learning, and life skills. It has been widely recognized as the leading known preventable cause of developmental disabilities in the United States.

This workshop will provide healthcare professionals with effective strategies that communicate a clear and meaningful message to women concerning the impact of their drinking behaviors before and during pregnancy on the health of their future children.



About the Presenter: Linda M. Caley, PhD, RN

Dr. Linda Caley is a Research Assistant Professor at the University at Buffalo School of Nursing. She holds a Doctorate from the UB School of Management, a Masters Degree in Nursing, and is licensed as both a pediatric and neonatal nurse practitioner.

She is currently conducting research on the needs of children and families affected by FASD, nursing interventions to prevent secondary disabilities in FASD, and methods to enhance planning of nursing interventions.

Dr. Caley teaches in the UB graduate program in child health and oversees the research of doctoral and masters students. She has extensive experience as a staff hospital nurse, substitute school nurse, and pediatric nurse practitioner.

Workshop Objectives:

- ▶ To identify the cause and effects of FASD and the risks associated with alcohol and other drug use during pregnancy
- ▶ To identify appropriate prenatal screening instruments for use with women of childbearing age
- ▶ To identify and practice brief intervention techniques for modifying risky behaviors
- ▶ To identify and develop ideas for preventing FASD in your own practice
